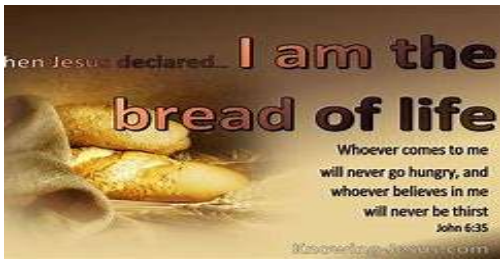

Jubilee Year



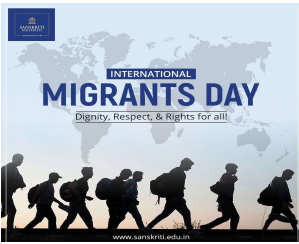
