Pope Francis Message for Lent 2025: Let us journey together in hope.

In his Message inspired by the Jubilee 2025 theme "Pilgrims of Hope" the Holy Father underlines that to journey "evokes the lengthy journey of the people of Israel to the Promised Land" and adds that "a first call to conversion thus comes from the realisation that all of us are pilgrims in this life". The Pope underlines that this journey is made together and explains that "Christians are called to walk at the side of others, and never as lone travellers"; it is necessary "to walk together, to be synodal" because "this is the vocation of the Church". In conclusion, he affirms it is necessary "to journey together in

hope, for we have been given a promise", in that "hope does not disappoint" (Rom 5:5). This is the third call to conversion, "a call to hope, to trust in God and his great promise of eternal life". The Pope encourages us so that hope "may be the focus of our Lenten journey towards the victory of Easter". For Lent, enriched by the grace of the Jubilee Year, the Pope offers several reflections on what it means to "journey together in hope" and discover the summons to conversion that God's mercy addresses to each one of us. St. John's Graveyard: A reminder that all NEW PLOT burials will almost certainly be a single depth coffin burial. A double burial will only be possible with one coffin and one ashes casket. It is important therefore that couples and families are aware of this restriction. Burials to an EXISTING PLOT may well be double depth, however, a test will be carried out to confirm this prior to the second burial. Please also note the following - IMPORTANT – It is a requirement of the church that NO CURBS be fitted to the grave with the Memorial Headstone, or at any time after the burial. There is a 300mm. maximum area from the Headstone (grave width) for flower holders etc. There may also be a requirement to have soil spoil temporarily over the plot when a burial is arranged to an adjacent plot.
