### “Maranatha come Lord Jesus”

#### Sacred Silence, Please

**As you enter, we invite you to keep a spirit of quiet prayer. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed, and your silence helps everyone to pray more deeply. Thank you for your reverence.**

“I am the light of the world,” Jesus said. “Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life.”

We don't have to look far to see the darkness present in our world. At times it seems to come closer to our homes and hearts every day. How we choose to respond to that darkness—in our lives, in society, and within our own souls—is a decision that shapes who we become. Jesus is the Light of the World, and He calls us to carry His light into every place that needs healing, hope, and peace. During Advent these colder, darker weeks of the year Catholics turn to the Advent wreath as a reminder that Christ's light grows brighter as we draw near to Christmas. St. Francis of Assisi beautifully said, “All the darkness in the world cannot extinguish the light of a single candle.”

Our Advent wreath traditionally holds four candles: three purple and one pink. Sometimes a white candle, the Christ Candle, is added and lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day to symbolize the presence of Jesus among us. Each candle reflects a different aspect of our spiritual preparation during Advent. One candle is lit each Sunday, and with every flame the world grows a little brighter.

**This week we light the first candle, known as: The Prophecy Candle – Hope // Colour: Purple**

Purple is the primary colour of Advent, symbolizing penance, preparation, and sacrifice. During this first week, we remember the Old Testament prophets who foretold the coming of the Messiah with great hope and longing.

As we begin this holy season, may we open our hearts to the hope Christ desires to give us.

*What hope is Jesus inviting you to rediscover this Advent?*

**St John's Graveyard burials -** Due to the ever-reducing availability, burials at St John's will be restricted to existing Parishioners unless space is available in an existing family plot. Unless ascertained at the time of the first burial into a new plot, burials will be single depth, however two burials will be possible with one coffin burial and one Cremation casket. Specification in a will may not guarantee burial at St Johns **IMPORTANT** - During the winter months, St John's Gardeners will be carrying out works to level the graveyard in front of the church. Initially it will involve spreading bark then soil and grass seed on top next year.

**Friday Mass Times -** During the dark winter nights Mass time will be changed to 6pm with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament before Mass at 5pm.

**Parish Council Meeting:** The next meeting will be held on today after the 9:30am Mass. A copy of the previous meeting (28th September) minutes has been circulated electronically to parishioners and displayed on the Church Notice Board.

**Expenditure -** The G/F Presbytery WC has recently been updated and replaced at a cost of £2,408; in addition to this expenditure, we estimate a cost of £24,000+ to replace the Presbytery Roof, and £25,000+ to replace to aging Cess Pit as the initial works of the 5 year Diocesan (Quinquennial Report), the report also specifies other works required to maintain the buildings. An additional emergency repair has been carried out this week to the roof.
